BELIEFS OF MUSLIMS REGARDING THE SAHABA (RADHIALLAHU ANHUM) (THEIR UNITED VIEW FOR OVER 14 HUNDRED YEARS)

The Sahaba Radhiallahu Anhum hold the place of the basis and foundation of explaining the Islamic text.

- In accordance with the Qur'aan and the clear Sayings (Ahaadith) of Rasulullah Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam.
- Seven hundred Aayaat (verses) of the Qur'aan and over two thousand Ahaadith of Rasulullah Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam.
- To degrade or dishonour them is to be led astray and to be misguided.
- To have enmity towards them is kufr (disbelief) and Ilhaad (to leave the fold of Islam).
- To show dislike towards them is to be rebellious and transgress the bounds of the Qur'aan and Ahaadith.
- All the Sahaba of Rasulullah Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam, approximately one hundred and forty-six thousand.
- Any differences between them should be viewed as sincerity on their part to promote Deen.
- Every objection raised against them and their honour, whether it be in lectures, writings or discussions.
- This whole group were the first to explain Islam to us in detail and have the distinction of being directed by the Prophet.
- This blessed Jama'at fulfilled the right of being in the companionship of Rasulullah Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam.
- Rasulullah Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam showed reliance on them in 27 battles (wars) and in 35 skirmishes.

- To speak any evil of them exposes ignorance of Islamic knowledge, for seven hundred Aayaat of the Qur’aan are devoted to their praise.
- The Ijtihaad (analogical deduction) of the Sahaba is truth – To have love for the household and family is a part of the religion.
- Sayyidina Ali and Hazrat Mu’awiyya (Radhiyallahu Anhumma) did not have any personal differences.
- According to Imaam Bukhaari (Rahmatullah Alayh), a mujtahid also receives one reward upon a fault.
- The Sahaba were the means of conveying the Qur’aan and Ahaadith to us.
- If the doors are opened for people to degrade, dishonour and criticize the Sahaba (Radhiyallahu Anhum), the doors of the Islamic religion will be closed.

It is thus necessary upon every single Muslim that he / she love and protect the honour of all the Sahab
